# **TRIDEL RECEIVES CITY OF TORONTO TREE REMOVAL PERMITS**

**27 November 2007**

**Toronto, Ontario** - Tridel has the go ahead from the City of Toronto to remove eight trees located in the Broadway and Yonge area. The trees have to be removed in order to facilitate the development of two condominiums and the new North Toronto Collegiate high school.

As part of the City approved landscaping plans, 72 new trees will be planted in the area and will be accompanied by the creation of a substantial green roof on top of the new school. This will take place once construction of the proposed development is complete.

A performance guarantee is also posted with the City of Toronto to ensure that planting conforms with Landscape Planting Plans as approved by the City of Toronto.

The tree removal permit was reviewed by the Urban Forestry Department before it was issued. An independent consulting arborist has confirmed that the trees slated for removal are either in fair to very poor condition.

The trees are scheduled to be removed on Wednesday the 28<sup>th</sup> of November 2007.
